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#### 2. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Main hazards: Extremely flammable. Irritating to eyes. Repeated exposure may cause skin dryness or cracking.

Vapours may cause drowsiness and dizziness.

Other hazards: In use, may form flammable / explosive vapour-air mixture.

## 4. FIRST AID MEASURES (SYMPTOMS)

**Skin contact:** There may be irritation and redness at the site of contact.

Eye contact: There may be irritation and redness. The eyes may water profusely.

**Ingestion:** There may be soreness and redness of the mouth and throat.

Inhalation: There may be irritation of the throat with a feeling of tightness in the chest. Exposure may cause

coughing or wheezing. Drowsiness or mental confusion may occur.

## 4. FIRST AID MEASURES (ACTION)

Skin contact: Remove all contaminated clothes and footwear immediately unless stuck to skin. Wash

immediately with plenty of soap and water.

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**Eye contact:** Bathe the eye with running water for 15 minutes. Consult a doctor.

**Ingestion:** Wash out mouth with water. Consult a doctor.

Inhalation: Remove casualty from exposure ensuring one's own safety whilst doing so. Consult a doctor.

## 5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

#### 6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Personal precautions: Refer to section 8 of SDS for personal protection details. Turn leaking containers leak-side up

to prevent the escape of liquid. Eliminate all sources of ignition.

**Environmental precautions:** Do not discharge into drains or rivers.

Clean-up procedures: Absorb into dry earth or sand. Transfer to a closable, labelled salvage container for disposal by

an appropriate method. Do not use equipment in clean-up procedure which may produce

sparks.

### 7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Handling requirements: Avoid direct contact with the substance. Ensure there is sufficient ventilation of the area. Do

not handle in a confined space. Avoid the formation or spread of mists in the air. Smoking is

forbidden. Use non-sparking tools.

ignition. Prevent the build up of electrostatic charge in the immediate area. Ensure lighting and

electrical equipment are not a source of ignition.
